Young Company

The Almeida Young Company brings together young theatre makers to create vibrant work inspired by big ideas. There are two ensemble groups: 14–18 years and 18–25 years. The groups meet weekly to develop acting, improvisation and devising techniques, as well as working with a wide variety of outside practitioners, exploring bold ways of giving voice to young artists. Each year, the two Young Companies work towards a final, end of year performance, working with industry-leading creatives on world-premiere productions.

Alumni from the Young Company have gone onto shows on the mainstage at the Almeida, The Kiln Theatre, been accepted into drama schools and gained agents.

The Almeida Young Critics is for young people aged 16-25, interested in interrogating a wide variety of creative arts within London's cultural scene.

Participants will have the opportunity to engage with theatre, dance and art throughout the year, as well as learn more about the process of creating work, from a critical point of view. The group explores different techniques to respond to these different styles of work, through critical reviewing, creative writing, podcasting and many more.

Youth Board

The Almeida Youth Board exists to provoke, inspire and create positive change at the Almeida. The board consists of 9 young people between the ages of 18 and 25 who are interested in arts leadership.
